There is some disagreement about best practices in teaching English as a foreign language

AIM/OBJECTIVE/PURPOSE

AIM : You need to have a goal you want to achieve And you should make the students aware of what the goal is before you start teaching. This gives them something to aim for and helps them stay focused on the subject.

LEVEL: Teach lessons appropriate to the level of the students in that class. You should make your lessons challenging, and push your students to achieve as much as possible, without making the lessons impossible.

PACE & VARIETY: Best teaching practice says that a lessons shouldn't lose its pace, and should contain a variety of Tasks.

CORRECTION : Student's errors sometimes need to be corrected, but there are ways to do this without focusing negatives as negative criticism.

ENCOURAGEMENT : Encourage your students to perform to the best of their abilities.

Peer-Teaching



Classmates are a valuable resource in helping English language learners to succeed, whether by showing students around the school in their first day or serving as a buddy in the classroom. Peers can help build student confidence and also act as language models, giving ELLs a chance to practice their new language skills in a low-stress setting.

Students who do not feel welcome or encouraged by peers are less likely to take risks and will feel less comfortable in the class room.

- Students receive more time for individualized learning.
- Direct interaction between students promotes active learning.
- Peer teachers reinforce their own learning by instructing others.
- Students feel more comfortable and open when interacting with a peer
- Peers and students share a similar discourse, allowing for greater understanding.
- Peer teaching is a financially efficient alternative to hiring more staff members
- Teachers receive more time to focus on the next lesson.
