- So, this awareness programme was successful.

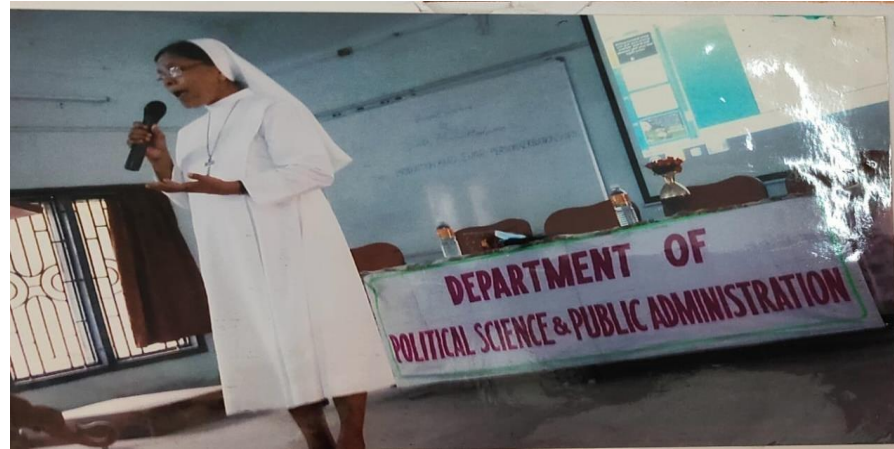
With this programme students got awareness-

GUEST LECTURE ON SKILL DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITY ON 18-7-2017.

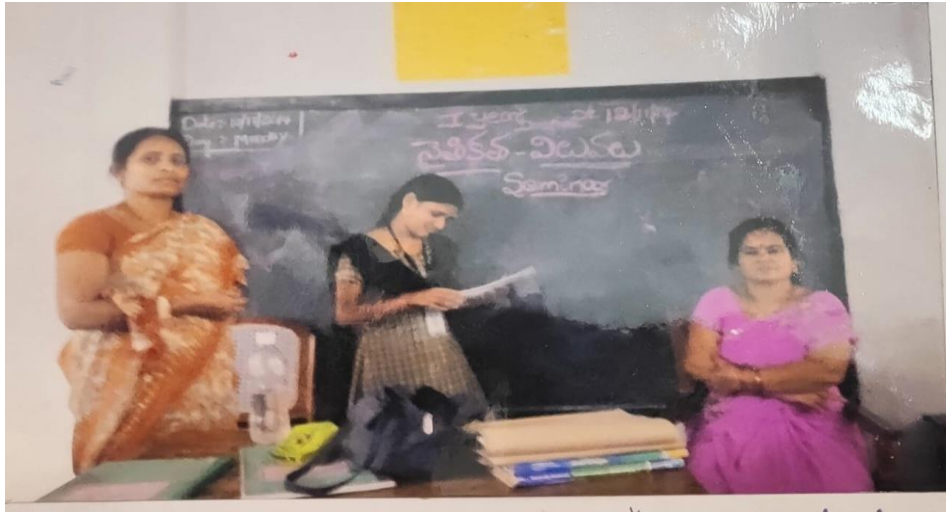
Students got knowledge about different designs, of various types through pinching thread on the cloth, made the girls saw practically.

DEBATE ON SPECIAL STATUS OF AP

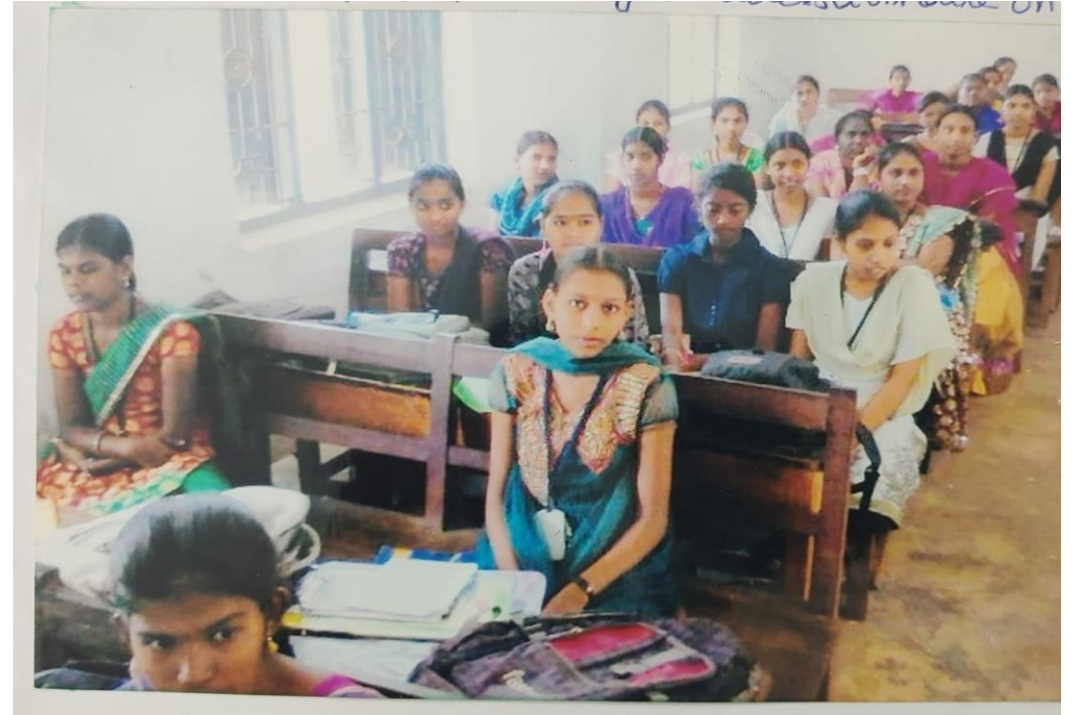
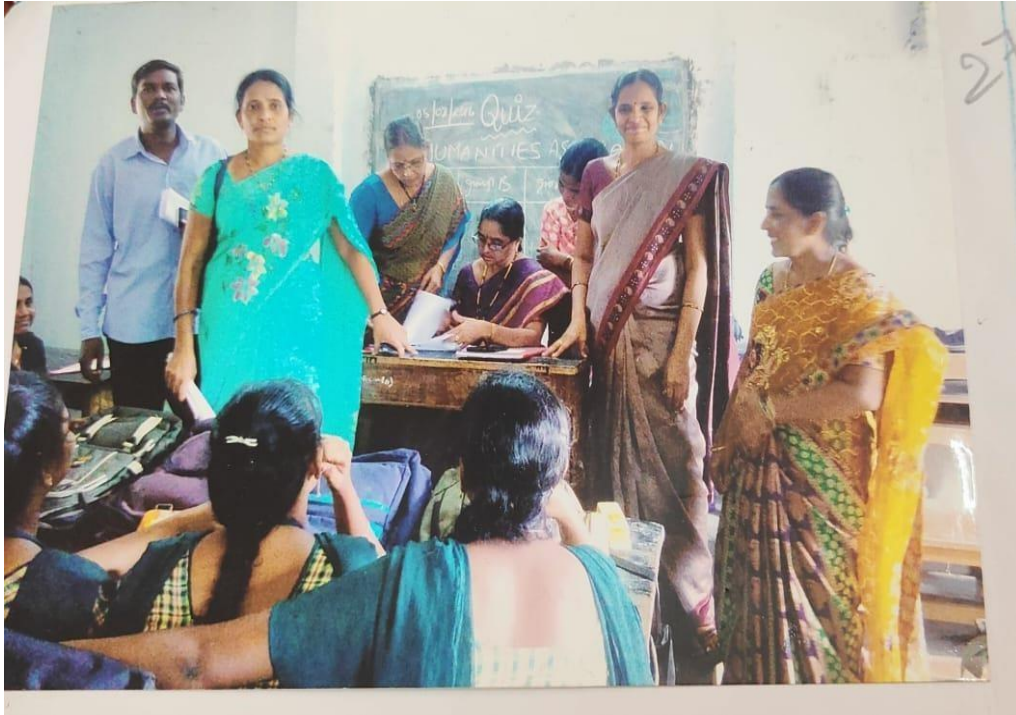
- Smt. B.V.B. Lakshmi and T. Mangayamma conducted debate on special status of AP.

Smt. B.V.B. Lakshmi, Incharge of the Dept. of Political Science and Public Admi attended along with students.

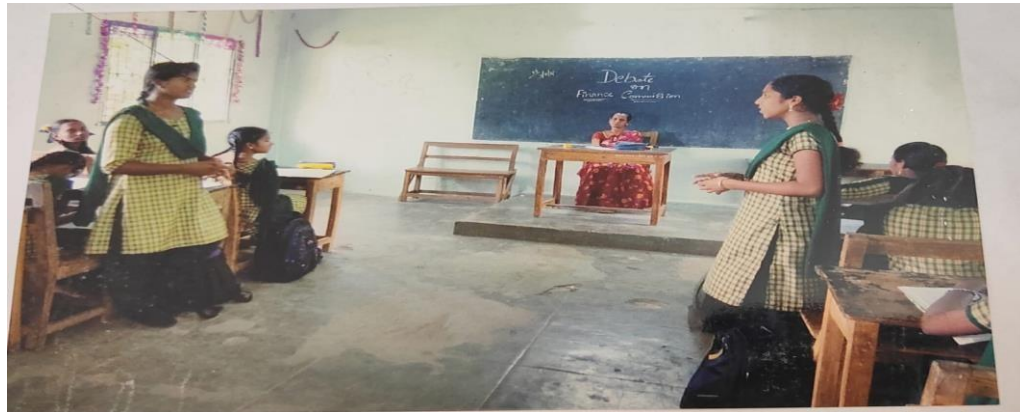


QUIZ PROGRAMME AND DEBATE

Sri. S. prasad was also conducted essay writing competition on the topic of “Coalition Politics”.



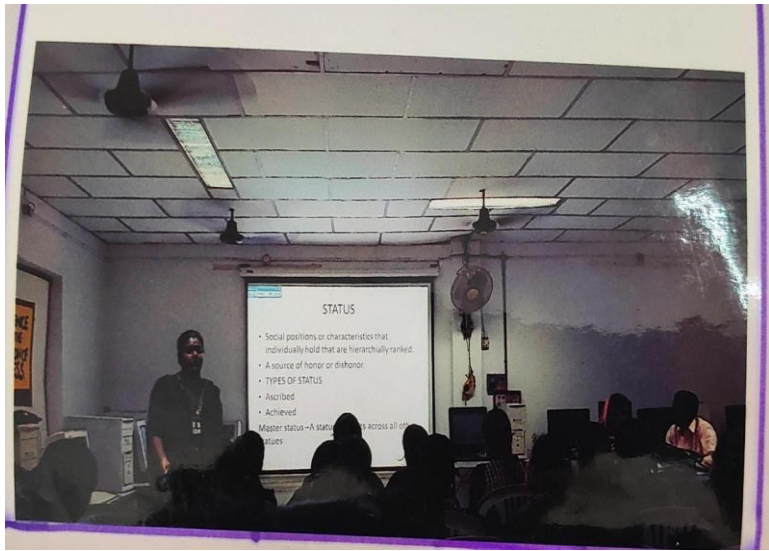
GUEST LECTURE ON WOMEN EMPOWREMENT

Politics department and Economics department was conducted guest lecture on Women empowerment. The students expressed their view on women who succussed in their respective fields.

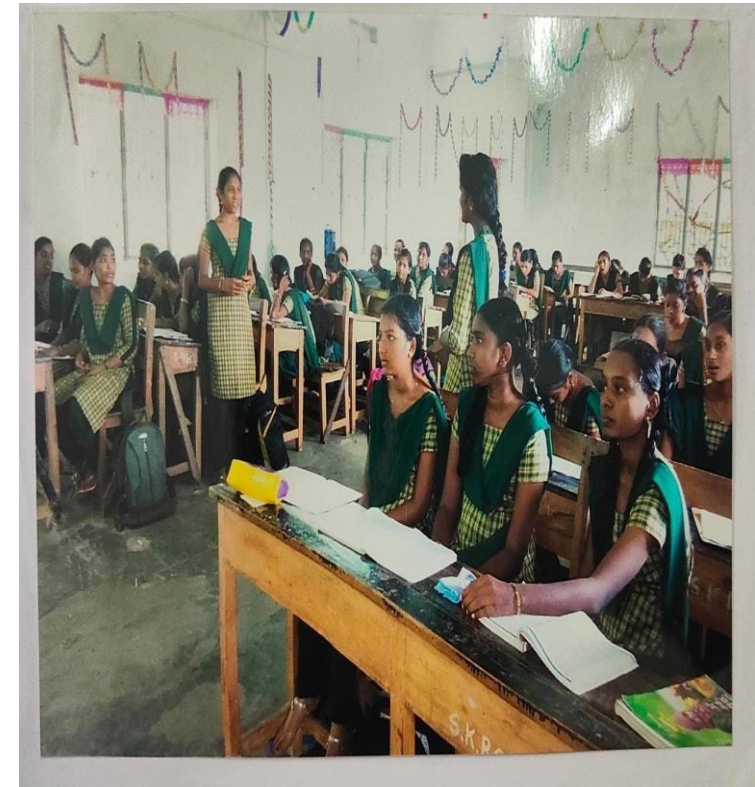
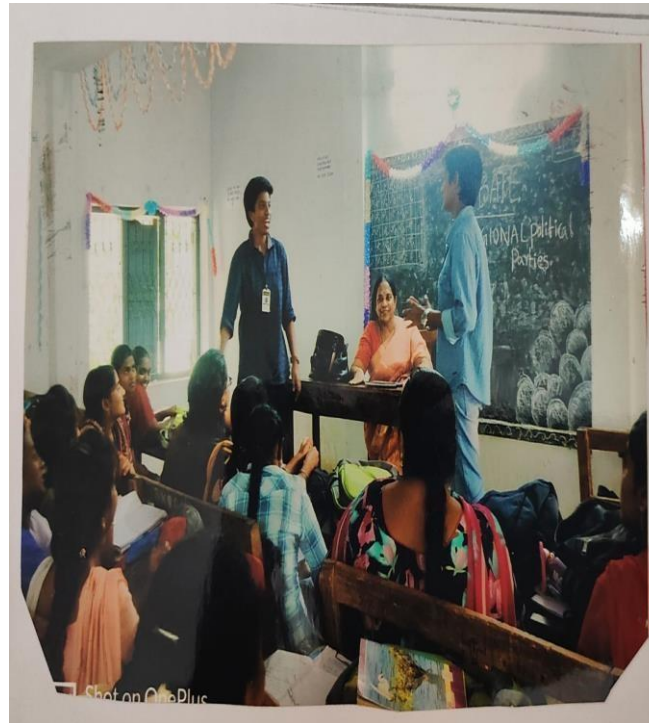

PPT on 370 article. This article gave special status to Jammu and Kashmir, will this be revoked?

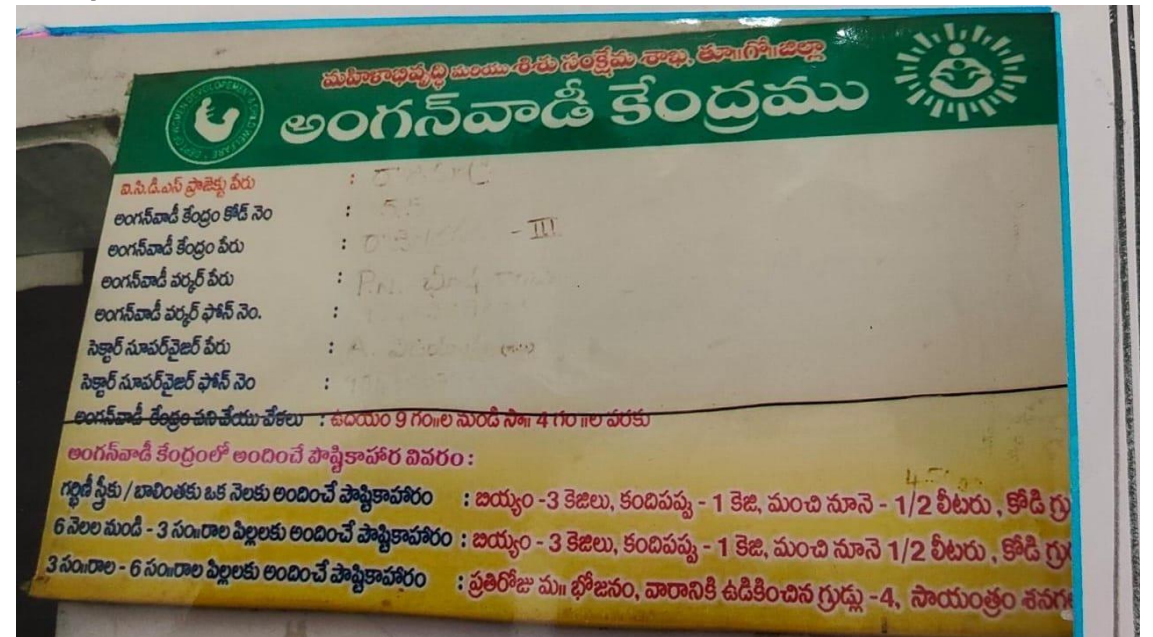


GROUP DISCUSSIONS AND QUIZZ

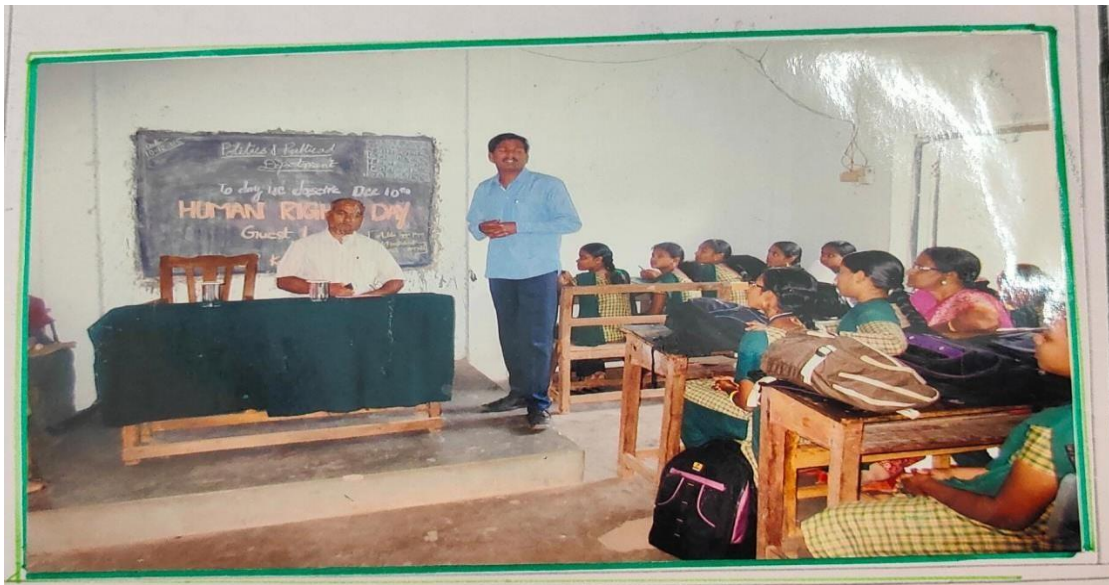
FLAG DAY
